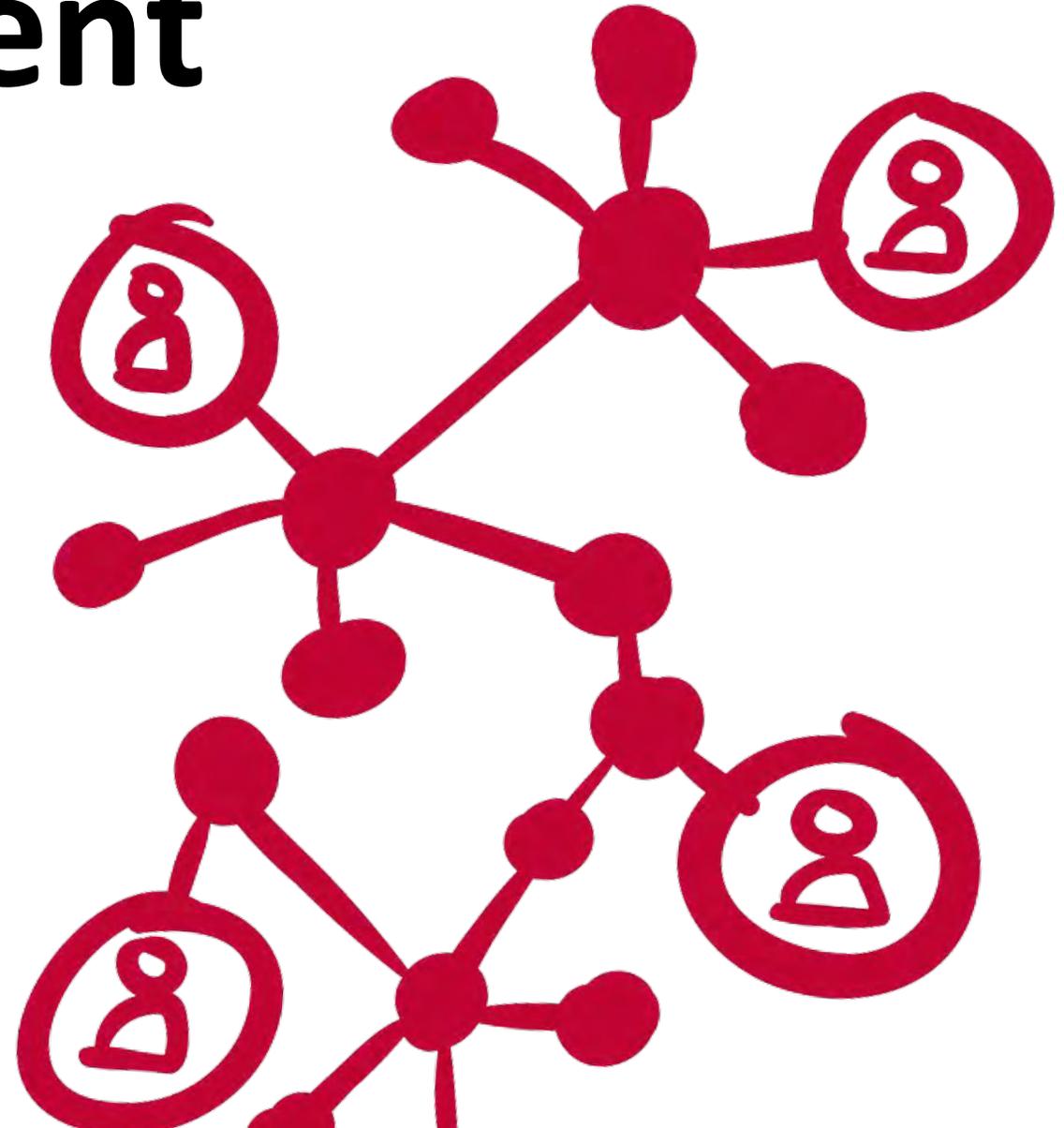


# MESA Community Involvement Model

## Community Involvement Model that:



1. Incorporates stakeholder input in **meaningful** ways.
  - Stakeholders include students, teachers, schools, districts, staff, board members, policy makers, industry, higher education, parents, and partners.
  - We are committed to making the process feel safe and equitable for all participants.
  - We are committed to sharing back with stakeholders how their input impacted policies and programs.



2. Provides a clear **vision** for the Executive Director.



3. Creates a clear, sustainable **strategy** for:
  - Communicating with stakeholders.
  - Ensuring clarity around decision making.
  - Providing a sense of why and how stakeholders are needed.



4. Leverages and values our **strengths**, especially:
  - MESA's vision and mission, grassroots structure, and program quality,
  - While also being willing to listen to, learn from, and adapt to what the community needs.

# Community Involvement Model



## **A**cquire Information & Buy-In

Staff host one-on-one meetings and Idea Forums with stakeholder groups to collect insights and build interest in key issues that impact MESA.



## **B**uild Policies & Strategies

Staff, Board, Teacher, and Community Working Groups use the gathered information to create overarching policies and strategies that guide decision making and action.



## **C**ollaborate to Implement Plans

Staff work with Regional Advisory Councils (RAC) to implement policies and strategies at the local level.



## **D**evelop Needed Resources

Staff and RAC reach out to the government, districts, industry, and funders involved earlier to request resources to support plans.



## **E**valuate Programs

Staff and external evaluators collect reflections from participants to improve programs.
